Rules of the Diving Carnival

1. Age is taken as at 31st December of that year.
2. All events are straight finals.
3. All IGSA Sport place getters (1st, 2nd & 3rd) will receive medals.
4. Repeat dives will be allowed if necessary in the team event only. Lower degree of difficulty will apply.
5. Please read the diver classification details for verification of IGSA Sport, invitation and team diver requirements.
6. Open platform and CIS trials for 12/13/14, 15/16 & 17/19 Years will be held during the IGSA Sport competition
7. Competitors, spectators, parents and coaches / staff are expected to behave in a safe and responsible manner and to comply with the IGSA Sport Code of Conduct.
8. Spectators and competitors are requested to be silent whilst dives are taking place and until any announcement is finished.
9. Competitors must return to their school seating and not remain on pool deck with coaches.
10. No eating or drinking is to take place on pool deck.
11. Only AHIGS approved photographers are allowed on pool deck during the day's events.
12. No changes to entries will be permitted on the day unless accompanied by a medical certificate or letter from the Principal. This must occur prior to the FIRST event and only ONE change per school is permitted.

Dive Recorder

All individual dive entries must be completed using the Dive Recorder program. Instructions are available on the IGSA Sport website. Please follow instructions carefully.

If assistance with Dive Recorder entries is required, please contact Chris Lang.

All Dive Recorder entries are to be received by the Diving Convener, Chris Lang clang@pymblelc.nsw.edu.au **by 13 March 2023**

A confirmation email will be returned by Dive Recorder if entries are correctly completed.

Competitors must check the dive sheet prior to their event on the day of the carnival.

Any issues with the dive sheets need to be raised with the convener prior to the start of the first event.

Diver Classifications

IGSA Sport Diver

An IGSA Sport diver is competing for their school in their correct age group or higher and can also trial for CIS. Additional dives may be required for some age groups.

They can only compete in one IGSA Sport age group and / or platform event.

They may dive in a higher age group for the IGSA Sport springboard competition or in the open platform and trial as a CIS diver in their appropriate age. This is at the individual schools' discretion.

Each school may only nominate one diver for the Open Platform event (point scoring). CIS Platform trials will also be held within this event. CIS divers must compete within their appropriate age group only.

An IGSA Sport diver cannot compete in the team event.

Team Diver

A team diver may only compete in the team event or as a CIS diver.

A team consists of a minimum of 3 divers up to a maximum of 6 divers.

A team may only include 1 CIS diver per school.

A team diver can only perform a maximum of 2 dives in the team event, regardless of division.

CIS Diver

A CIS diver (CISD) is competing in the IGSA Sport CIS trials to be considered for selection in the IGSA Sport Representative Team for CIS, on springboard and / or platform and **only if they are of a competitive standard appropriate for CIS selection**. This will be at the discretion of the IGSA Sport Convener and Diving Committee.

A CISD result is not included in the IGSA Sport point score nor will they receive medals.

A CISD can only dive in the age group they turn this year for both springboard and / or platform and must complete the required CIS dives.

Division 1 – maximum 12 CIS divers across all age groups for springboard and maximum 9 divers across all age groups for platform.

Division 2 – maximum 6 CIS divers across all age groups for springboard and 6 divers for platform.

Clashes

Girls competing in both swimming and diving must complete their list of dives prior to the conclusion of their age group. Referees must be informed.

Presentations for all events in a session will be conducted immediately at the end of the last event for that session.

All times are approximate only – ensure you are there a minimum of 30 minutes before the approximate time of your event warm up.

Individual warmup time will be limited due to the extensive program of events.

First 5 places in age springboard and platform events will progress to the CIS Championships on the 2 May 2023.

Trophies & Point Score

Age Group Champions

The diver with the highest individual point score in the following age divisions will receive a trophy:

- Junior – 12 & 13 Years
- Intermediate – 14 & 15 Years
- Senior – 16 & 17+ Years

Division 1 and Division 2 Champions

Schools will compete in either Division 1 or Division 2. Both divisions will have the same point scoring system and the winning school from each division will be presented with a shield.

Most Improved School

This is awarded to the school who improves their position in the final point score by the most places from the previous year. If multiple schools are drawn, the school with the largest points increase is most improved.

Champion School

The highest total point score is deemed to be the Champion School.

The point score for all springboard age groups, open platform and the team event is allocated as follows: -

The diving point score was combined with the swimming point score from 1923 - 1992.

The first presentation of a shield for the overall point score for diving was made in 1993.
